Immunization Requirements for Students in Kindergarten, Grades 1, 2, 3, 4, & 5

Dear Parent/Guardian,

New York State Law Section 2164 requires certain immunizations (shots) to enter kindergarten and attend school. Please check with your health care provider as soon as possible to make sure that your child has all the needed immunizations.

Required Immunizations for Kindergarten & Grade 1, 2, 3, 4, & 5

Immunization	Number of Doses
Polio	4 doses or 3 doses if the 3rd dose given at 4 years of age or older
Hepatitis B	3 doses (properly spaced out)
Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis	5 doses or 4 doses if the 4th dose given at 4 years of age or older or 3 doses if 7 years or older & series started at age 1 or older
Measles/Mumps/Rubella	2 doses
Varicella (Chickenpox)	2 doses

Students have 14 days from the start of school to receive all required vaccinations to avoid exclusion.

Proof of immunization must be **any 1 of the 3** items listed below:

- An immunization certificate signed by your health care provider
- Immunization Registry report (NYSIIS or CIR from NYC) from your health care provider or your county health department (Niagara County Health Department's number is 716-278-1903)
- A blood test (titer) lab report that proves your child is immune to the diseases (only applicable for Measles/Mumps/Rubella/Varicella and Hepatitis B)
 - For varicella (chickenpox), a note from your health care provider (MD, NP, PA) which says your child had the disease is also acceptable.
