### Immunization Requirements for Students in Grades 6, 7, 8, 9, & 10

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New York State Law Section 2164 requires certain immunizations (shots) to enter and attend school. Please check with your health care provider as soon as possible to make sure that your child has all the needed immunizations. They are listed below.

Immunization	Number of Doses
DTap / DTP	3 doses
Tdap	Age 11: Must receive an immunization containing Tetanus toxoids, diphtheria, and acellular pertussis (Tdap)
Polio	4 doses or 3 doses if the 3 <sup>rd</sup> dose was received at age 4 or older
MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)	2 doses
Hepatitis B	3 doses or 2 doses of adult hepatitis B vaccine (Recombivax)
Varicella (Chickenpox)	2 doses
Meningococcal conjugate (MenACWY)	1 dose Grade 7 or 8* or 9*

\* Most of the students in grade 8 and 9 will have already received the MenACWY vaccine dose in grade 7, unless transferred from out of state or out of country. MenACWY vaccine is not required per NYSDOH for grade 10.
